

HOUSING OPTIONS

For The SAN FRANCISCO ABOLITIONIST ACADEMY



Most trainings will be conducted at the beautiful Clunie Conference Center, operated by Westmont College. We highly recommend that you stay at the Clunie Conference Center. If you choose to take advantage of this residential aspect of the program you are able to synthesize the experience with others exposed to the same level of intense interactions and trainings. The feedback we have received from attendees is that staying at the training site very much adds to the overall experience.

PAYMENT:

- Full Housing and Board Payment (\$250 per week and \$50 per additional night) is, at latest, due upon arrival for your session.

ROOM & BOARD INFORMATION:

- Rooms are doubles and triples. If you are coming in a group we can attempt to group you together. Please inform us prior to your arrival.
- Food is self-catering. We supply food and you cook... we recommend that you bring recipes and share with others!
- Singles are not available unless there is extra room due to cancellation(s)
- Bring your own bedding supplies and/or sleeping bag.
- Rooms have their own bathroom with shower.
- The house has a total of 26 total beds.
- WiFi internet connection is provided.
- Three computers/printer stations are available for use.
- The house is tobacco and alcohol free.
- Parking is very limited in this neighborhood –as it is in all of San Francisco—don't bring your car, if you can avoid it.
- We recommend you pack lightly!
- Earthquake prepared, the house is prepared with two weeks of food and water for 26 people.
- House meets all stringent San Francisco fire codes.

TO/FROM THE AIRPORT:

We highly recommend you fly into San Francisco (SFO) airport – other options are Oakland (OAK) and San Jose (SJC).

Not For Sale does **not** provide transportation to/from the airport. Here are three ways to get to/from the San Francisco airport:

- **Super Shuttle** is a door-to-door van service; it is between \$18 and \$20 with tip one-way and is very convenient. There are signs in the airport directing you to “door to door van services”. You can make a reservation on line prior to arrival or get walk up service.
- **Taxi** is about \$45 one-way including tip. You can catch a cab outside the doors of the airport.
- **BART** (mass transit) train system, which leaves from the airport and comes into the city. Follow signs to the in-airport to the BART station. You’ll need to take the train towards San Francisco and get off at the Montgomery Street Station – although any one of the four city stations would be fine. Then take the 21 Hayes bus to the corner of Hayes Street and Lyon Street. You’ll be one block from the house.
- 511.org – plan your trip from the airport to the house using Bay Area mass transit.
- [Next MUNI](#) – up to the minute data on bus arrival times. You can use this to get around the city during program down times.
- **Note: The last BART train runs at 11:45pm. Starting again at 6am**
